### **Good news from Croatia: Establishment of CROSSDA and hiring of new staff**

Croatian Social Science Data Archive (CROSSDA) was established in May 2020 as a faculty centre at the University of Zagreb Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences and it is now on the way to initiate formal institutional cooperation with relevant research, policy and infrastructure organisations in the country. Two research assistants - one sociologist and one psychologist will be hired for a period of 6 years. They will work on the promotion of secondary data analysis and improvement of research reproducibility and replicability, and they will participate in teaching statistics and methodology for students.
