I am happy to announce, that after a year of consultation with its constituencies, CESSDA ERIC has launched its new strategy cycle 2023-2027.

The new strategy captures the latest developments in the research data landscape and in the European Research Area (ERA): the digital transformation of data and software; the increasing cross-fertilisation and FAIRification of research and the way it is conducted and rewarded; and looks ahead to the growth and potential uses of the research data economy.

To anticipate and provide services to CESSDA members, the European social sciences research community and stakeholders from policy and industry, CESSDA collectively will focus on three strategic strands: DATA, PEOPLE and LANDSCAPE (in terms of how data influences the research community, policy and society).

As you will see in the strategy document, CESSDA ERIC embeds these three core strands throughout its objectives, with the aim of providing interconnectivity to Service Providers and their national research communities.

I am very much looking forward to continuing and expanding the fruitful work with CESSDA's community and partners.

FAIR-IMPACT has just launched the second Open Call for Support, offering three defined support actions for one-toone support to help candidates to selfassess their current capabilities and to develop FAIR implementation action plans. Applications are open until 1 November.

GLOBAL DIMENSION AND SUSTAINABILITY OF RESEARCH INFRASTRUCTURES

25-26 SEPTEMBER

Research infrastructures conference held as part of the Spanish Presidency of the Council of the European Union

From 25 to 26 September a high-level conference on research infrastructures as part of the programme of the Spanish Presidency of the Council of the European Union took place in which CESSDA Director Bonnie Wolff-Boenisch participated.

The event brought together main European and international actors in the research infrastructures scene. The discussions revolved around two axes: sustainability challenges of research infrastructures and the global dimension of them.

On the final day the '<u>Declaration of the Spanish Presidency of Tenerife</u>', on research infrastructures in the global dimensions was published. A total of 14 countries have so far adhered to the initiative promoted by the Ministry of Science and Innovation within the framework of the Spanish Presidency of the Council of the European Union.

The declaration of Tenerife is a continuation of the Brno declaration in 2022 and the Lund conference in May 2023 and shows that research infrastructures continues to be a priority in the European Research Area.



22 September 2023 EOSC Symposium 2023 and the EOSC Future meetings

CESSDA attended the EOSC Symposium in Madrid, participating in sessions on EOSC Future, BY-COVID, RITrainPlus and FAIR-IMPACT.

1 September 2023 Cross-disciplinary use of socioeconomic data in vaccine research

A BY-COVID workshop organised by DANS-KNAW/CESSDA gathered participants to promote the use of socioeconomic data in vaccine and infectious disease research, in particular for the BY-COVID Baseline Use Case on vaccine effectiveness.

3 August 2023 <u>CESSDA looks back at the TRIPLE</u> <u>project</u> Since 2019, 22 partners from 15 countries have worked on developing the multilingual discovery service GoTriple, which covers 11 languages and 27 disciplines in the social sciences and humanities.





5 July 2023 Over 130 participants selected for the RItrainPlus management training programme

The RItrainPlus management training programme is designed for professionals in research infrastructures and core facilities. The programme, organised for the first time as a pilot in summer 2023, has attracted a lot of interest and received 277 applications from over 40 countries.
