Information on transport in Belgrade

TAXI in Belgrade

The passenger is only required to pay for taxi services according to the current price list and to the amount indicated by the taximeter at the end of the journey.

Negotiating a price for taxi services, where the taximeter is not switched on, is not recommended, especially at the airport.

From the airport to the city centre, it is recommended to take a coupon at the Taxi window at the airport. With that coupon you are safe to use a legal taxi. Vehicles are parked in front of the airport. The passenger needs to show the coupon when entering the taxi.

These taxi companies are the most reliable.

Also, passengers can use CarGo or Yandex taxi, via mobile applications.

City Public Buses in Belgrade

Belgrade city public transport is provided through a network of bus, trolleybus and tram routes run by GSP "Beograd" and bus services operated by private bus companies, on around 130 routes.

Single tickets (BusPlus) can be bought:

- In public transport vehicles, from the driver (price is 200rsd / 1.80 EUR).
- At kiosks marked with a ticket sales sticker (price is around 250rsd 2.10 EUR), and then to pay for one ride (price is 89rsd / 0.74 EUR). The passenger can use that card for 90 min on all lines (in public transportation zones 1 & 2).

This 90 min card **must be checked-in on the card reader every time you enter another vehicle.** The card reader is located at the entrance of each vehicle.

There are also **express minibus services** which are slightly more expensive, but also more comfortable and quicker as they do not stop at every bus stop.

From the airport to the city centre, passengers can use bus number 72 (the bus station is in front of the airport). The last station for this bus is Zeleni Venac (Zeleni Venac is near the hotels in the center).

Also, passangers can use bus A1, ticket is 300rsd (about 2.5 EUR). The route of this bus is from the Airport "Nikola Tesla" to the Slavija Square.

Parking in Belgrade

As in all big cities, finding a parking space in the central streets of Belgrade during working hours is very tricky and we recommend vehicles to be parked in a public car park.

Parking zones

Parking areas on the streets in the centre of Belgrade are divided into three parking zones where parking time is limited and payment is made for each full or incomplete hour:

- Red zone maximum 1 hour;
- Yellow zone maximum 2 hours:
- Green zone maximum 3 hours.

Parking areas within these three parking zones are indicated by special traffic signs bearing the colour of the zone as well as by road markings. Parking is payable in all three zones on week days from 07.00-21.00 and Saturdays from 07.00 to 14.00. Once the allowed time has expired, the driver must move his or her vehicle. The penalty for not doing so is a parking fine.

Payment methods for parking in the three zones are:

- **Parking tickets** these are purchased at kiosks and other points of sale. The time of arrival should be written on the ticket and it should be displayed on the inside of the windscreen.
- **Parking ticket machines** (only in the red zone) machines selling parking tickets take coins and electronic parking cards.
- **Mobile phone** by sending an SMS containing the registration number of the vehicle (for example BG123456, without spaces) to 9111, 9112 or 9113 (depending on the zone), from any mobile network.

Public car parks

Instructed by the Traffic Police, illegally parked vehicles are towed away to several different locations, depending on the location of the vehicle:

- from Novi Beograd and Zemun: Staro sajmište
- From the city center: Vidin kapija and Slavija
- From the south of the city: Ada Ciganlija

A police fine and vehicle towing tax are payable.

Illegally parked vehicles towed at the instruction of the public utilities' inspectors (in the event that they were parked on a grass surface) are towed to:

The public utilities fine and vehicle towing tax are payable.
