# Aims of the subtask:

- Creating a state-of-the-art description regarding the needs of the CESSDA member and partner institutions;
- Knowledge on how the existing resources to meet the needs of the CESSDA member and partner institutions;
- Conclusions and recommendations for the future development of the CESSDA member and partner institutions;
- Outputs/recommendations to be used as input in preparation of the future internal and EU funded projects (i.e. INFRADEV-3 2019 proposal in development at the moment).

# State of play :

- Currently, there is no substantial information about the needs of CESSDA members and partners, but in 2018 a study about the expectations should be conducted and could afterwards serve as a basis for the future cooperation.
- In 2018, the ambition is to collect information about the needs of the service providers (examples of possible service support include creation and publication of metadata, publication of data related materials or datasets, storage of files, support to researchers in use of the archiving system to put data online, etc.)

# Types of activities to collect information

1. Resource directory: With the analysis of this tool from the aspect of the needs we can earn a picture about the CESSDA member institutions;
2. Interview/survey with the partner institutions (connect to the survey providing by the ADP);
3. Additional questionnaire (if necessary) after the autumn Widening Activity event

1. Promising established infrastructure with activities
2. Established national data service seeking support for becoming full CESSDA members (i.e. main reason why the country did not reach the member status in the CESSDA ERIC)
  - Administrative reasons
  - Stakeholders aspect

  - Other lack what is limiting the DAS
