Why an online module based guide?

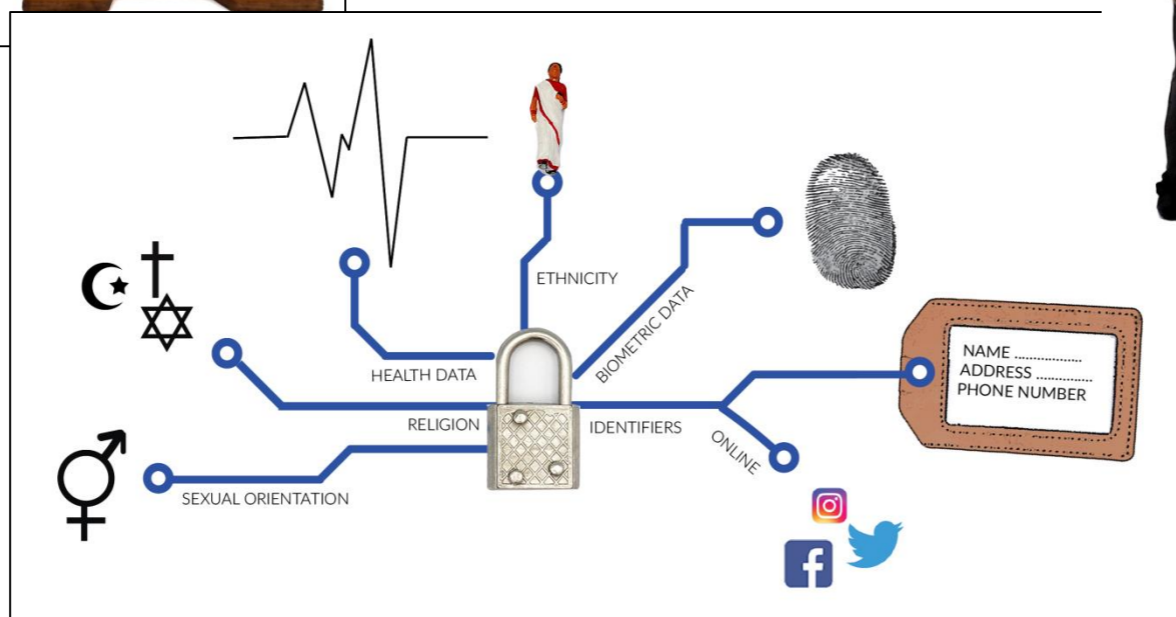
- Share good training practices, examples and content

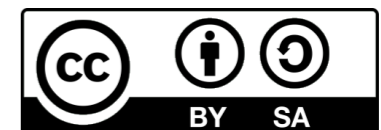
# How the module can be used
